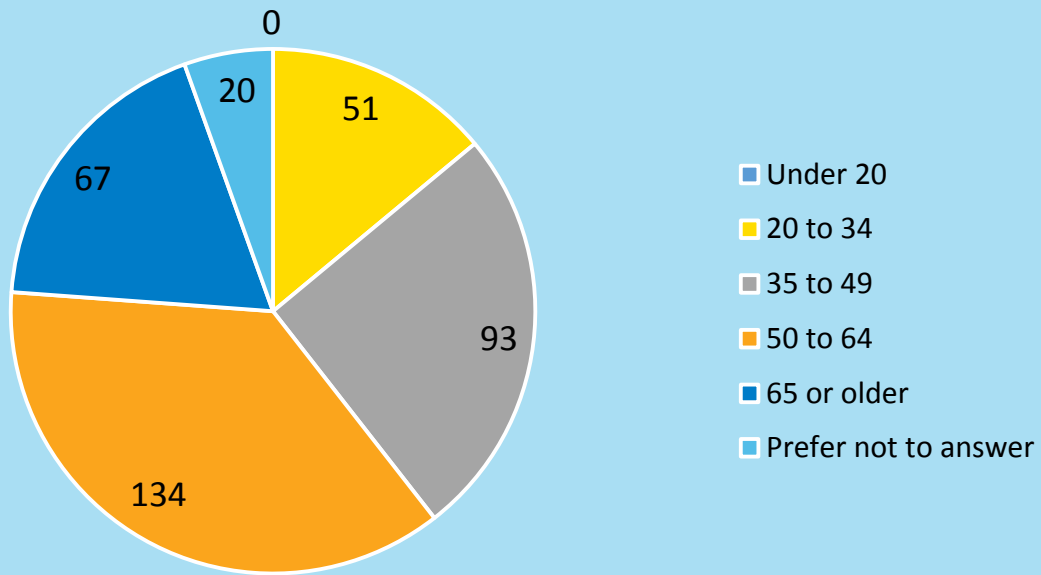

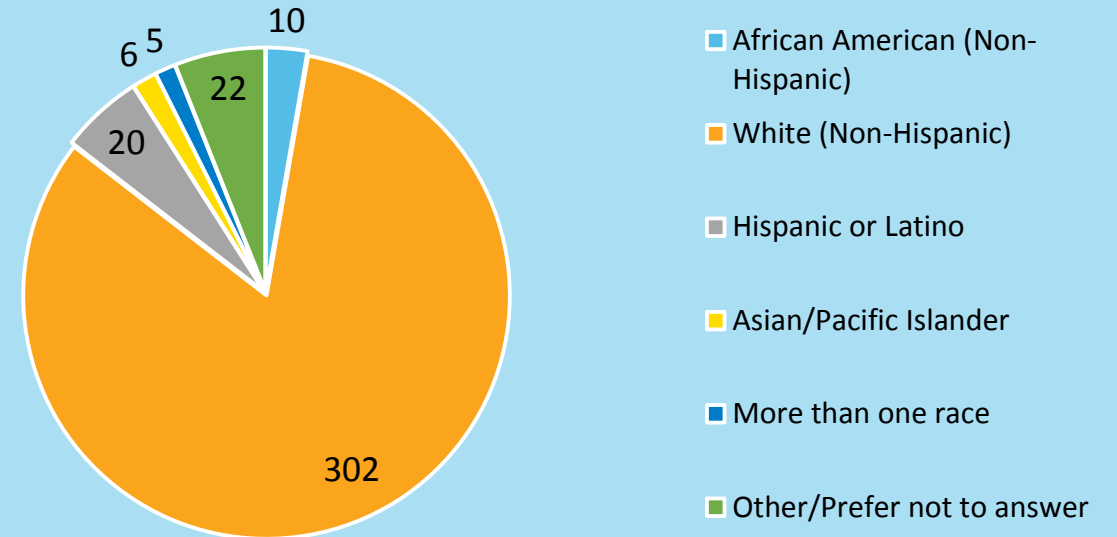

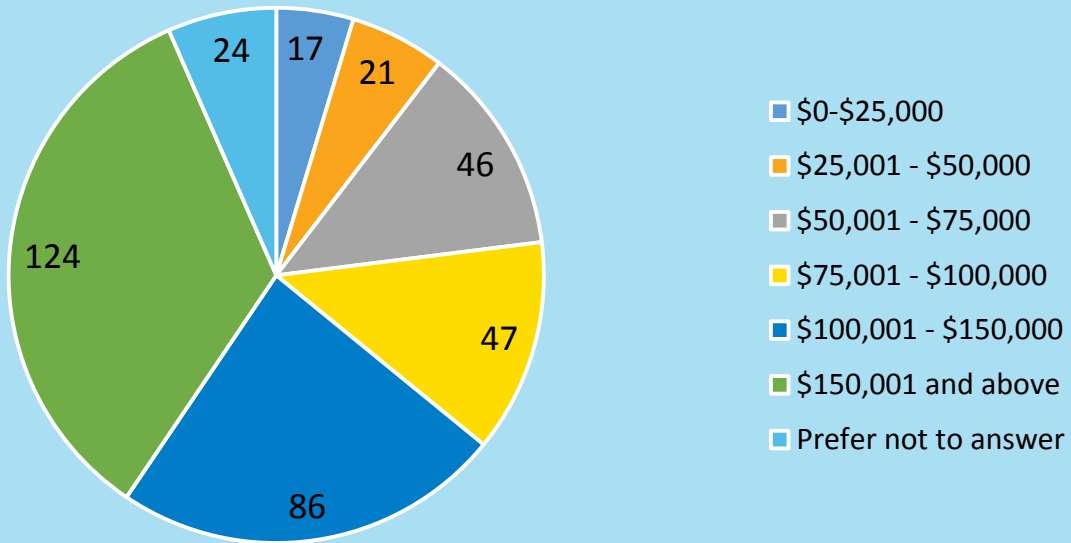

HOUSEHOLD INCOME

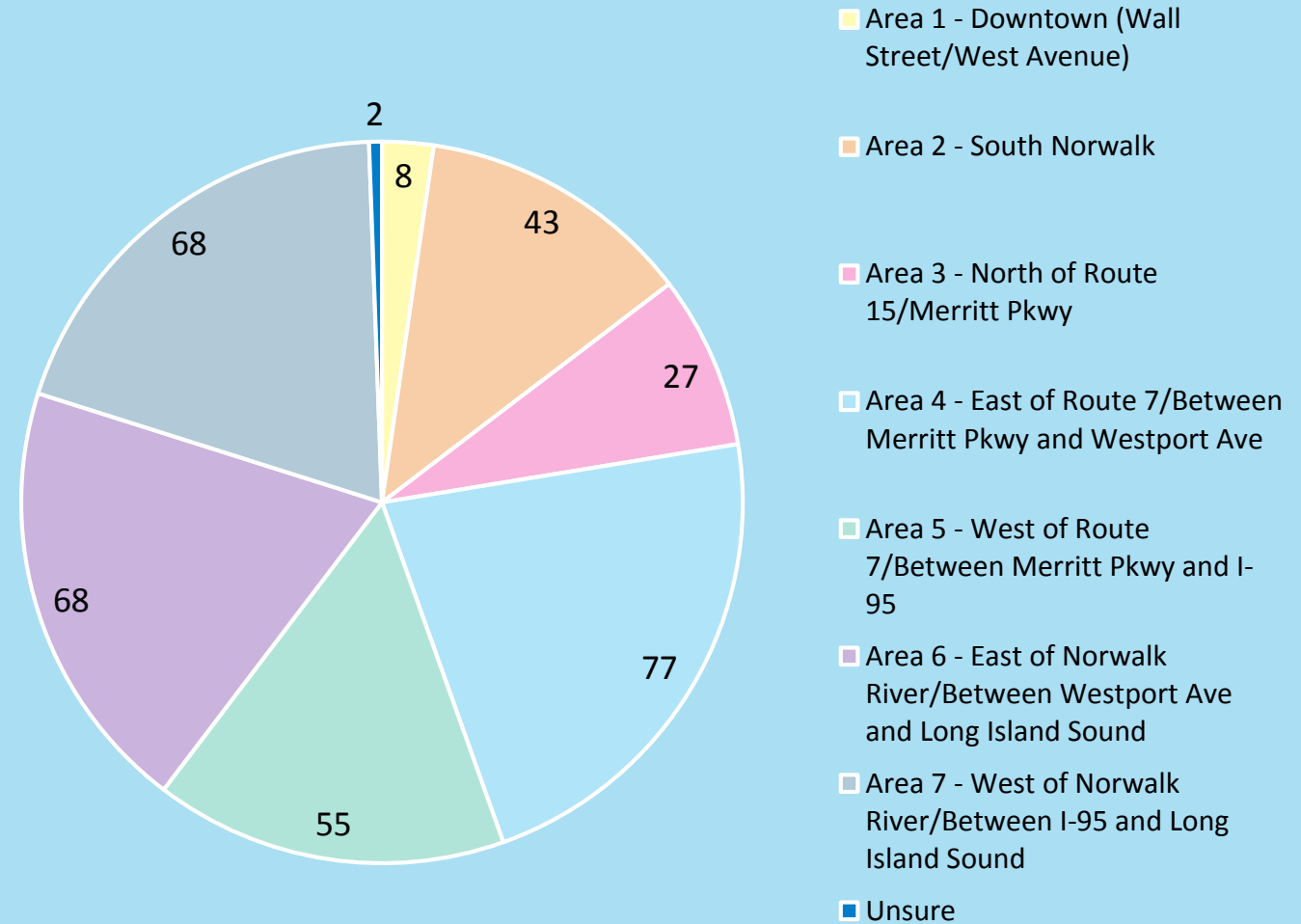


LENGTH OF NORWALK RESIDENCY





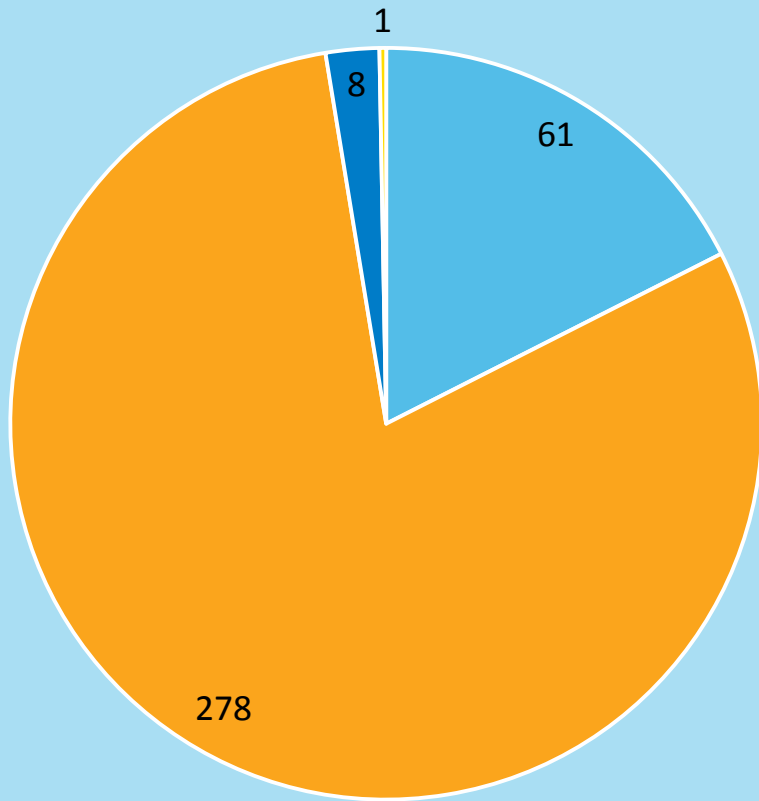
WHERE DO YOU LIVE IN NORWALK?

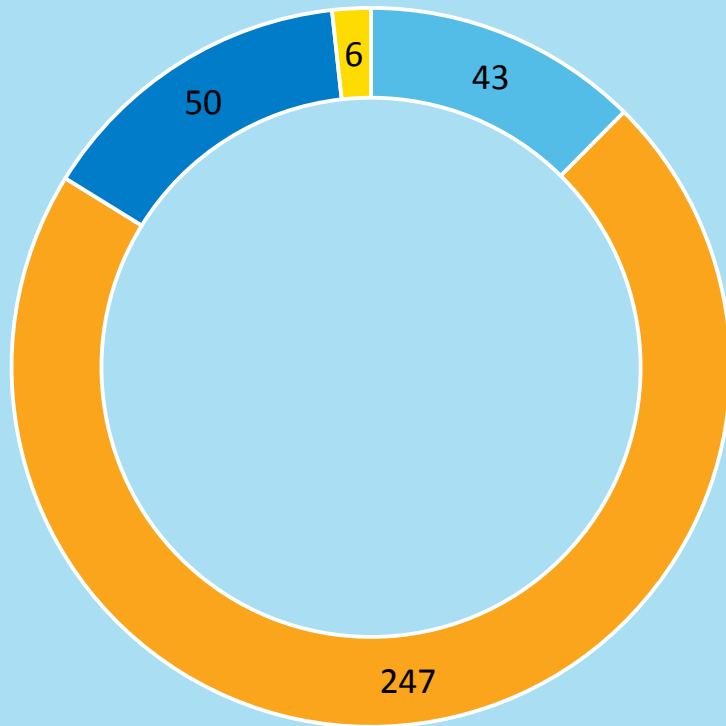

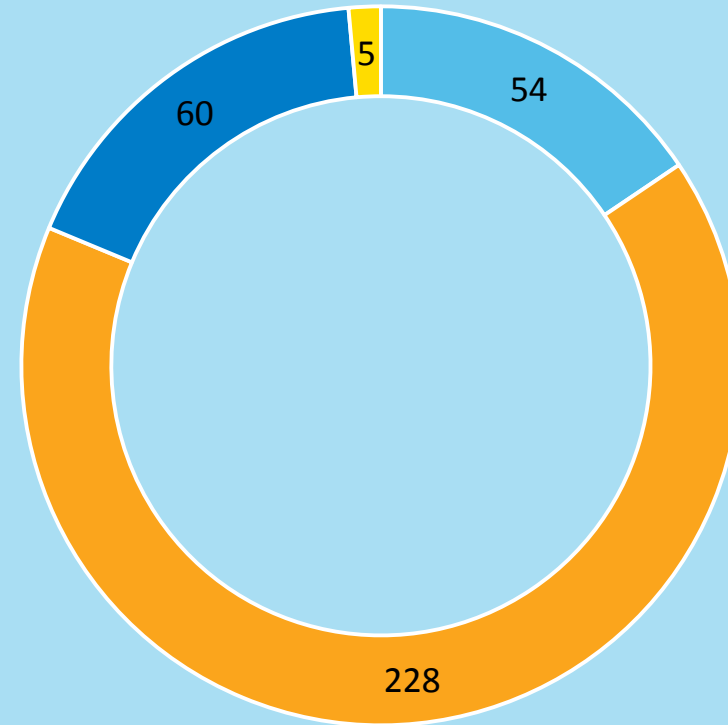

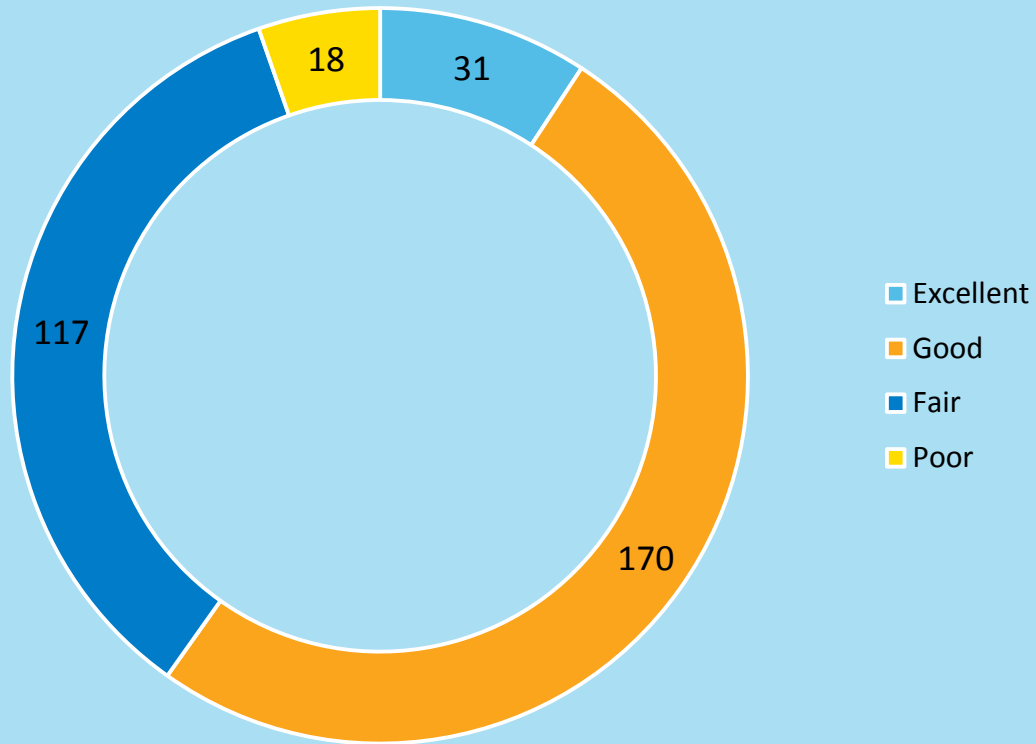

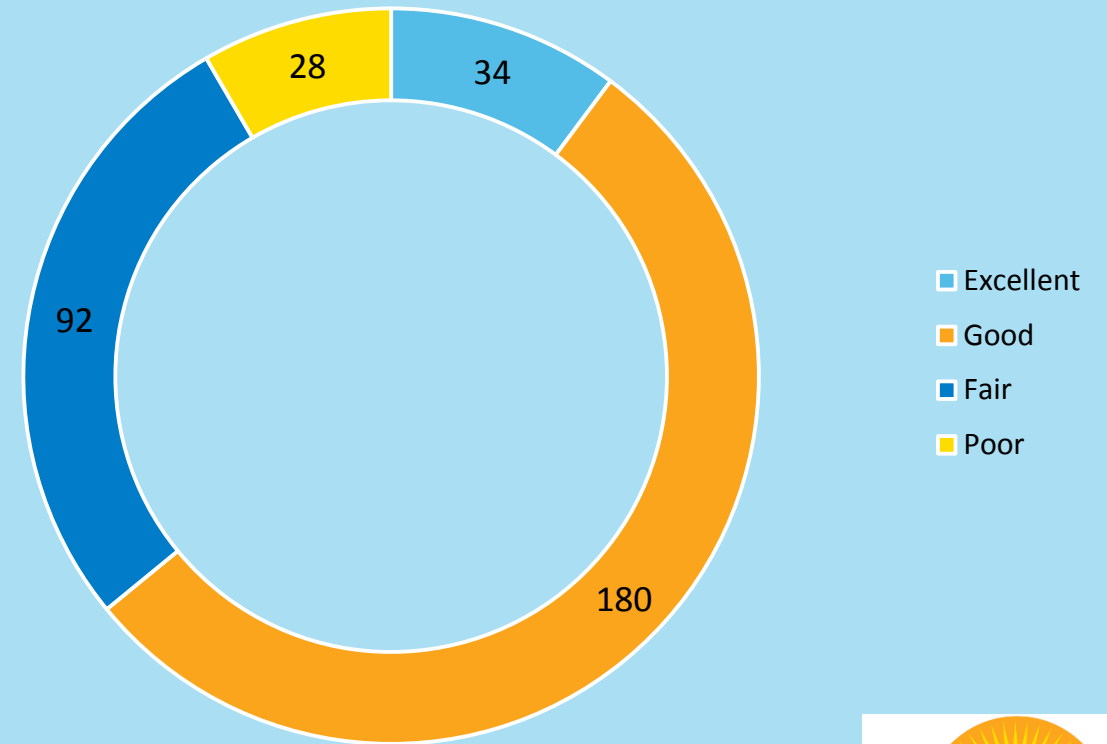

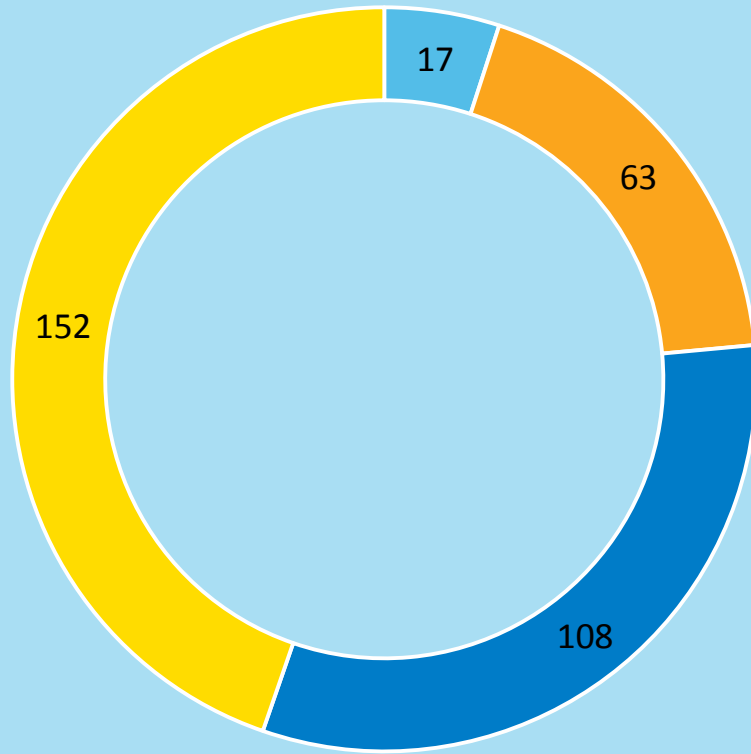

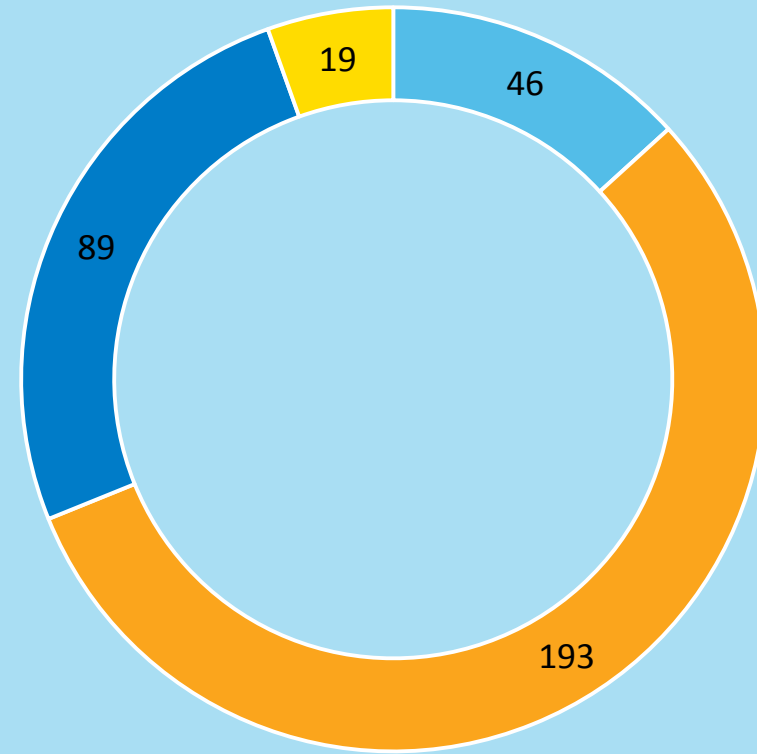

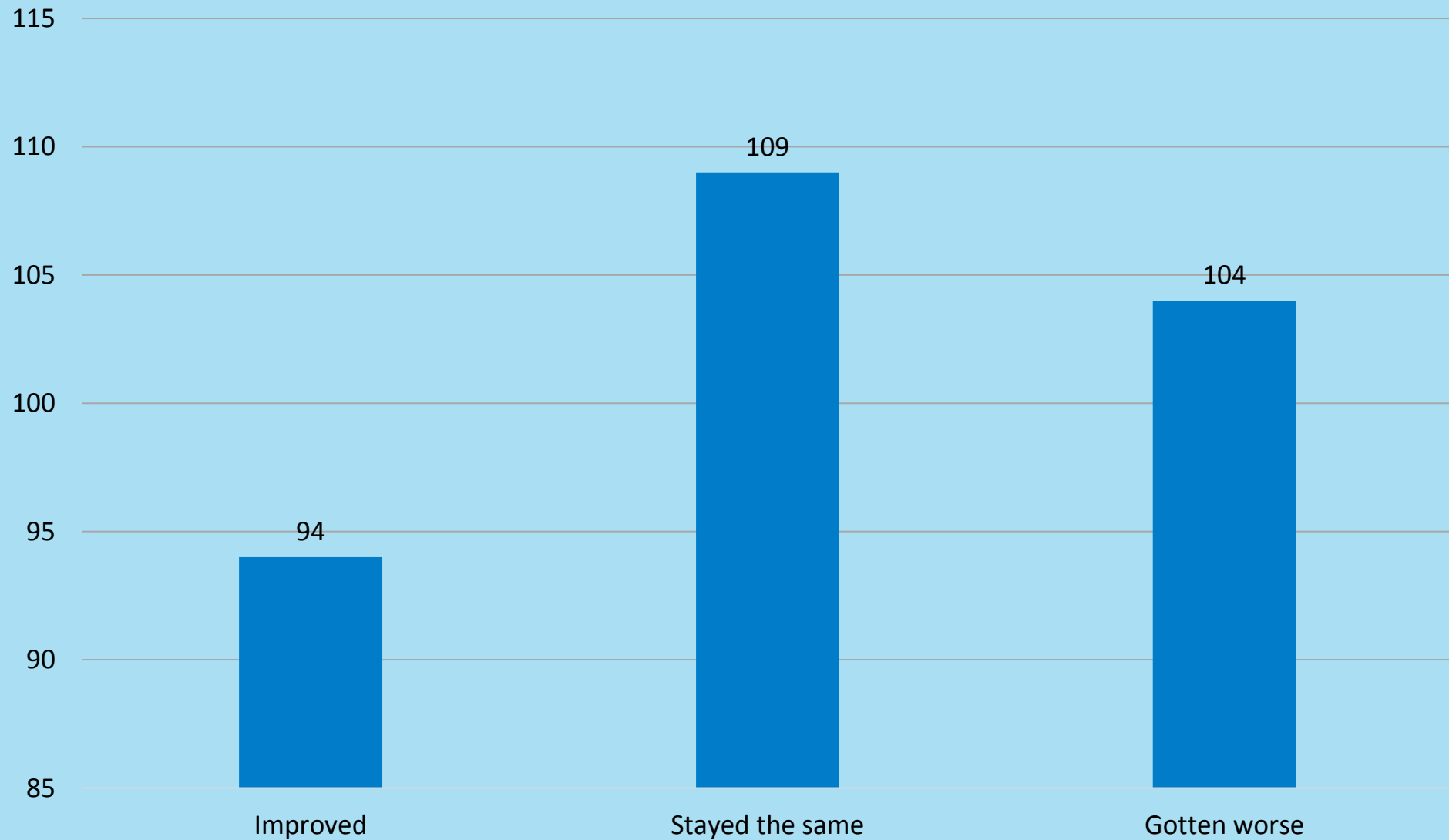

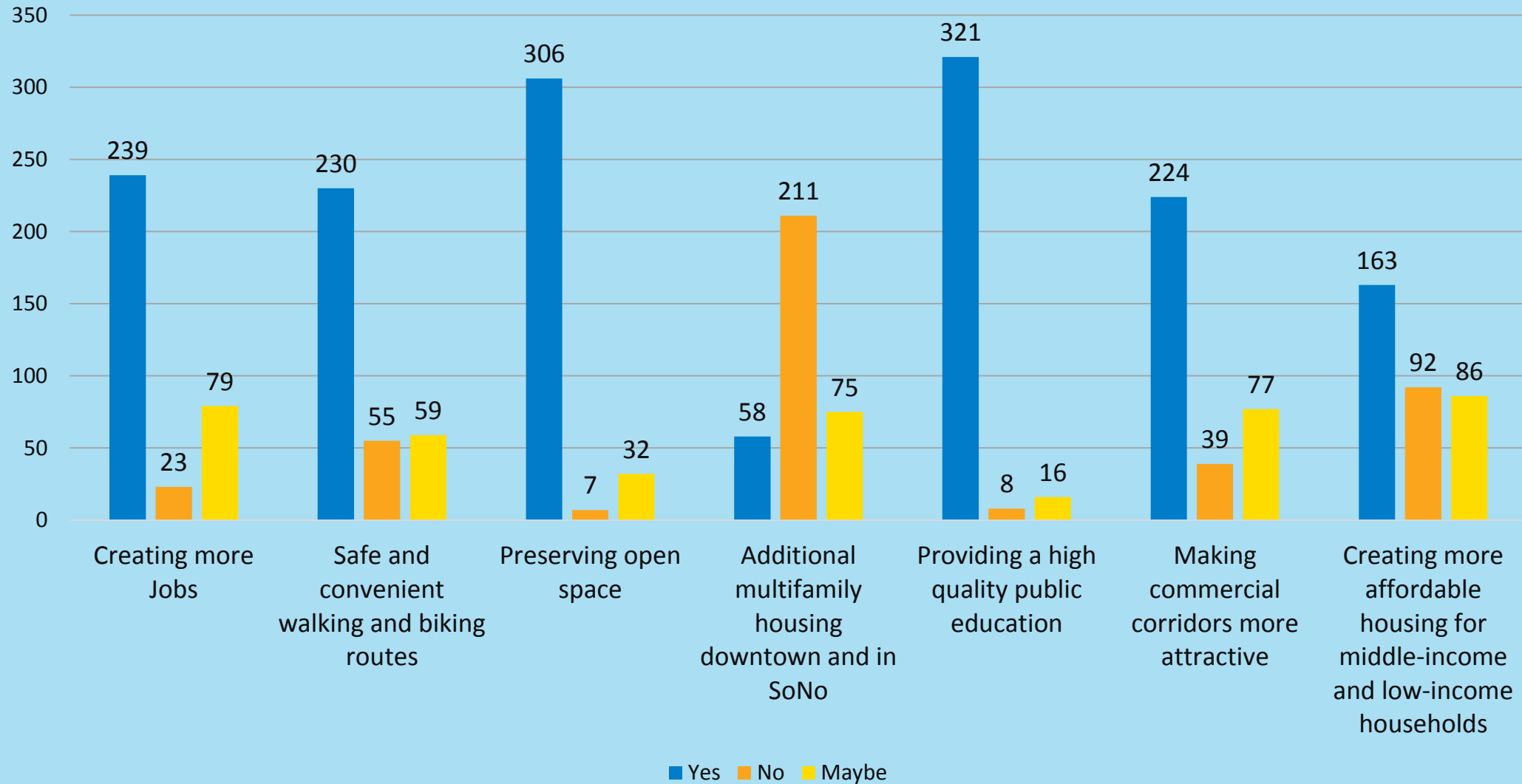

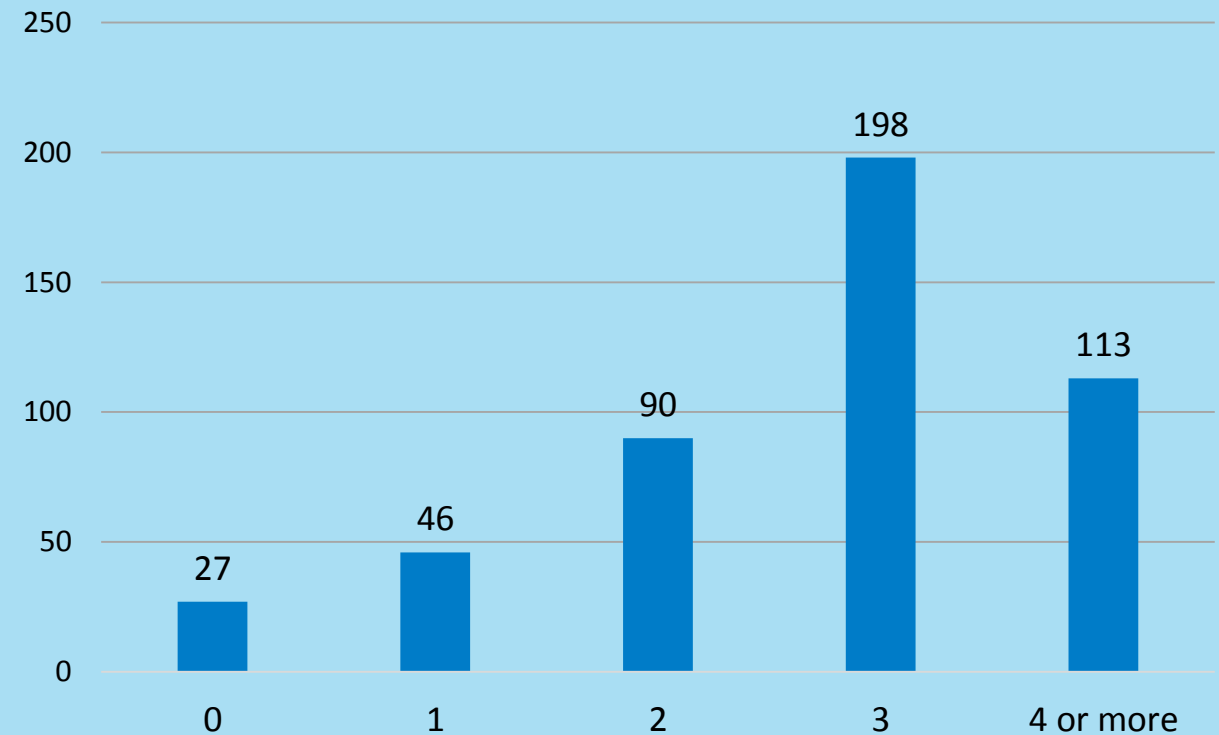


Vehicles Owned – Parking Spaces Available (off-street)

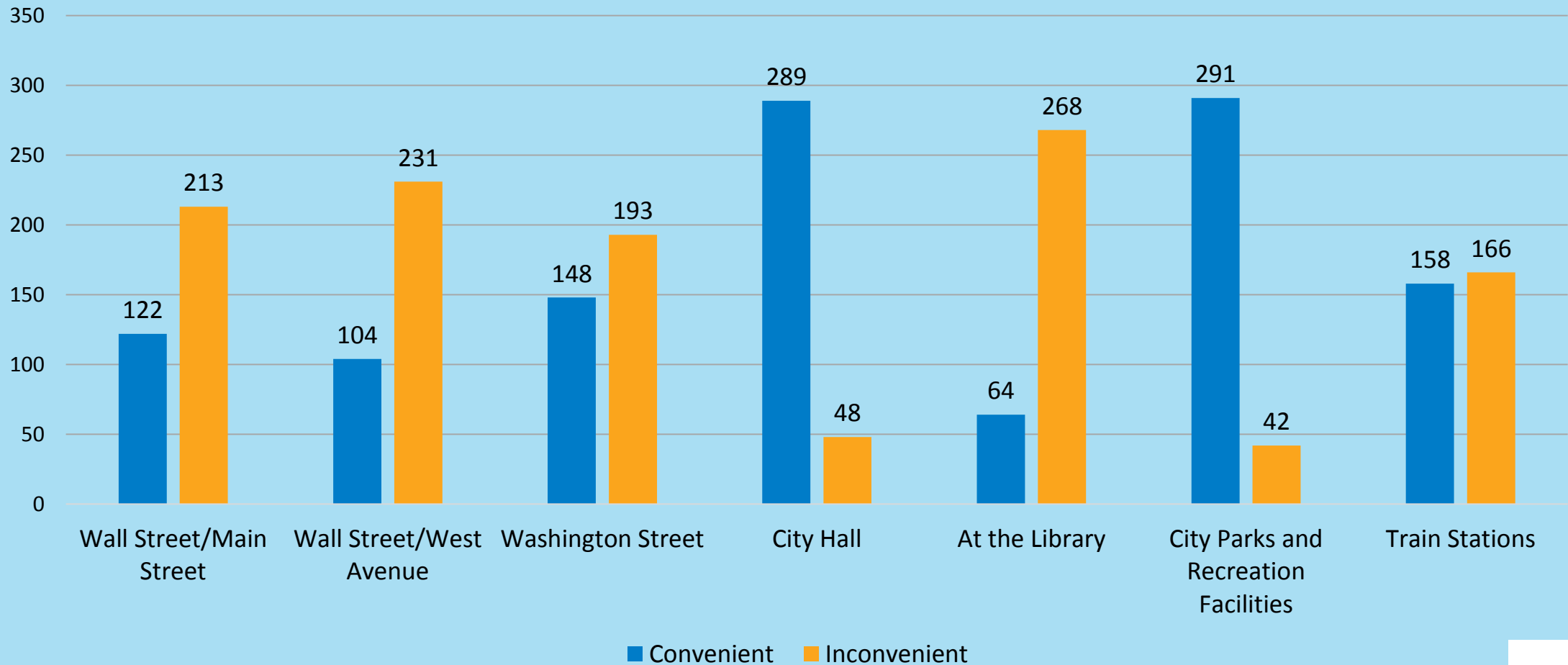

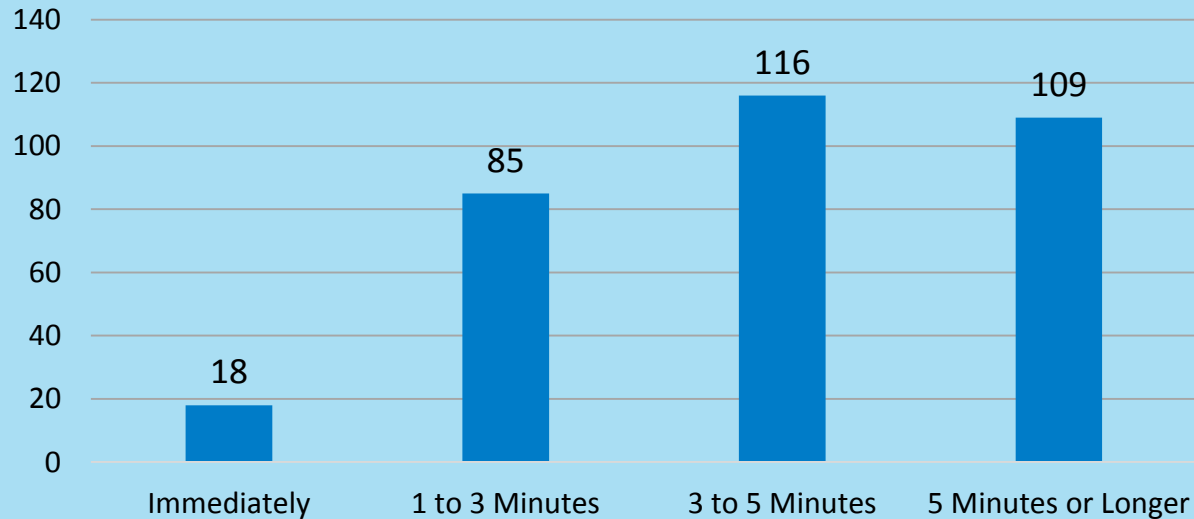


Is Parking in Norwalk Convenient or Inconvenient?

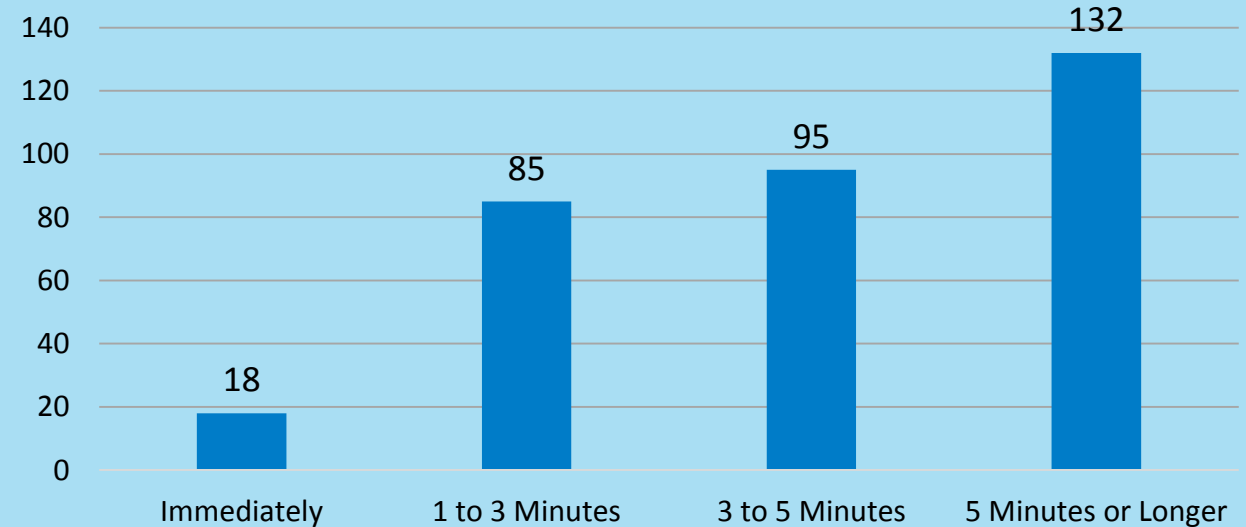

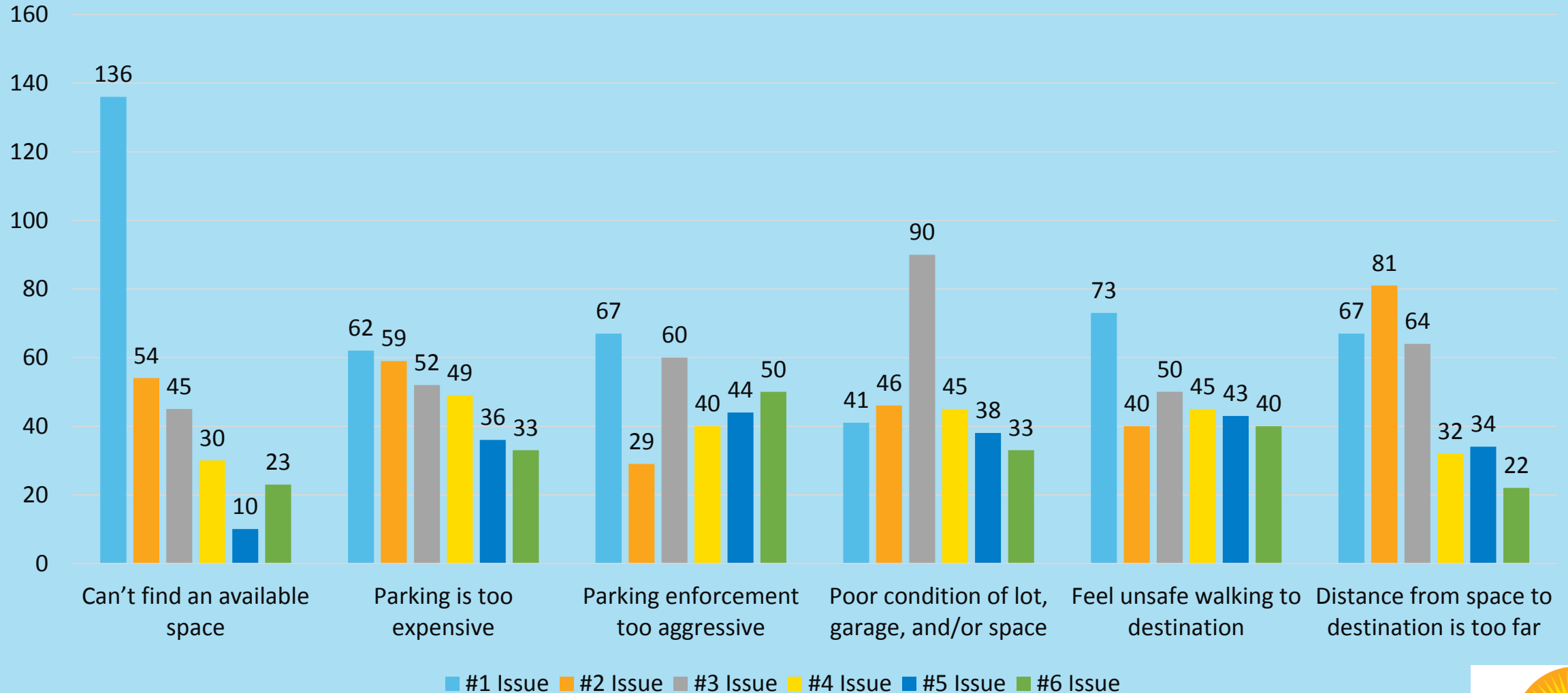

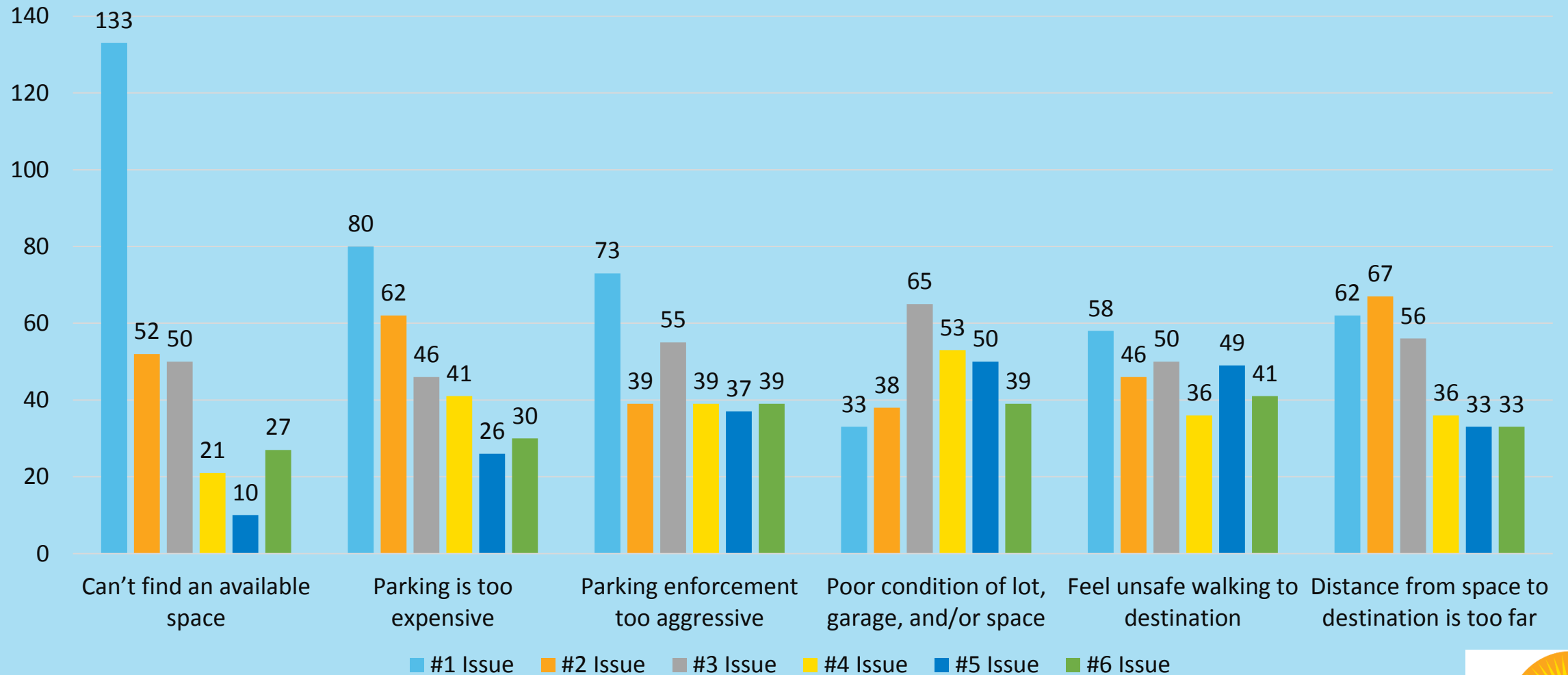
