





Area 3 - North of Route 15/Merritt Pkwy







AS A PLACE TO RAISE A FAMILY












Has the quality of life in Norwalk gotten better over the past 5 years?






Vehicles Owned – Parking Spaces Available (off-street)



Is Parking in Norwalk Convenient or Inconvenient?






How long does it take you to find a space...

AROUND WALL STREET AND WEST AVENUE




